

## **UEM Edgenta Contributed Food Aid To 1,000 Flood-Affected Families In Segamat**

**KUALA LUMPUR, 22 March** – UEM Edgenta Berhad (“UEM Edgenta” or “Company”), the region’s leading Asset Management and Infrastructure Solutions company, contributed food aid worth RM 50,000 to 1,000 families who were severely affected by the recent floods in Segamat, Johor.

At the height of the floods in early March 2023, Segamat had more than 13,000 flood victims, where almost 80 per cent of the residential areas within the district were submerged under water.
